# Corrado Maria Saglietti

## **Français:**

Corrado Maria Saglietti, né en 1957 à Costigliole d'Asti en Italie, a étudié le cor avec G. Zoppi et obtenu son diplôme avec les plus hautes distinctions. Il est engagé depuis 1977 à l'Orchestre Symphonique National de la RAI de Turin, devenant premier cor en 1990. Il se produit fréquemment en soliste ou dans des concerts de musique de chambre. Il obtint son diplôme de composition au Conservatoire de Turin en 1986 avec les professeurs Santo Tresca et Gilberto Bosco.

Les œuvres de Corrado Saglietti ont été récompensées par de nombreux prix de compositions internationaux et sont jouées avec succès par des solistes et des ensembles de renommée mondiale.

## **English:**

Corrado Maria Saglietti was born in 1957 in Costigliole d'Asti, Italy. He studied horn with G. Zoppi and graduated with highest honors. Since 1977 he has been playing in the RAI National Symphony Orchestra of Turin, and in 1990 he became principal horn; he often plays chamber music and performs as a soloist. In 1986 he received his degree in composition from the Turin Conservatory where he studied with professors Santo Tresca and Gilberto Bosco.

Corrado Saglietti's works have been awarded several international composition prizes and are played worldwide successfully by renowned soloists and ensembles.

## **Deutsch:**

Corrado Maria Saglietti, 1957 in Costigliole d'Asti in Italien geboren, studierte Horn mit G. Zoppi und erhielt sein Diplom mit höchster Auszeichnung. Seit 1977 spielte er im Nationalen RAI Sinfonieorchester in Turin, wo er seit 1990 das 1. Horn spielt. Er tritt solistisch oder in kammermusikalischen Besetzungen auf. 1986 erhielt er am Turiner Konservatorium sein Diplom für Komposition mit den Professoren Santo Tresca und Gilberto Bosco. Corrado Saglietti's Werke sind mit internationalen Kompositionsspreisen ausgezeichnet worden und werden weltweit erfolgreich von renommierten Solisten und Ensembles gespielt.

## The Work

This collection is intended for young horn players and pianists. It stimulates them and makes them grow while having fun.

Simple in appearance, these *little pieces* are nevertheless musically rich in details and colors. The carefully thought out melodies evoke both classical and modern styles.

The *12 Little Pieces for Little Recitals* allow the performers to evaluate their technical and musical qualities while learning how to express and transmit them to the audience.

## L'œuvre

Ce recueil est destiné aux jeunes cornistes et pianistes. Il les stimule et les fait évoluer en les amusant.

Simples en apparence, ces *petites pièces* sont pourtant musicalement riches en détails et couleurs. Les mélodies, soigneusement pensées, évoquent les styles classiques et modernes.

Les *12 Little Pieces for Little Recitals* permettent aux interprètes d'éprouver leurs qualités techniques et musicales tout en apprenant à les exprimer et les transmettre au public.

## Das Werk

Diese Sammlung ist jungen Hornisten und Pianisten gewidmet. Sie ist anregend und auf unterhaltsame Weise weiterentwickelnd.

Die scheinbar einfachen *kleinen Stücke* sind jedoch musikalisch reich an Details und Farben. Die sorgfältig ausgearbeiteten Melodien erinnern an klassische und moderne Stile.

Die *12 Little Pieces for Little Recitals* ermöglichen es den Interpreten, ihre technischen und musikalischen Qualitäten zu erproben und gleichzeitig zu lernen, diese auszudrücken und dem Publikum zu vermitteln.
