






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Jukka Viitasaari



English: **Jukka Viitasaari** (b. 1961/aka "Viitasaurus") has had many decades of success as a composer for wind bands. He has been awarded seven Finnish and 16 international band composition contest prizes to date. He has performed with brass bands, wind bands, and, true to his generation, big bands and rock bands.

Since 2008 he is a member of the Finnish Composers Society and a WASBE board member for 2019-2026. He also serves on the board of The Finnish Wind Band Association SPOL and FinnBand, Finnish Band Publishers United.

Viitasaari has more than sixty works published in Finland and over twenty others in the U.S. by TRN Music Publisher, BRS-Music, Potenza Music, Leading Tones Music, Grand Mesa Music and Alfred Music and in Europe by Carpe Diem Musikverlag.

He has presented clinics at Penfield High School 2013 and Arizona State University in 2018 on the writing music for bands. In 2019 he co-presented with composer Jukka-Pekka Lehto "A Shape of Finns to come" -lecture at the WASBE World Conference in Buñol, Spain in July 2019. In 2022 he presented clinics in Riga Latvia (the Finnish wind band scene) and Linköping, Sweden (Nordic Composers Seminarium on writing for different band levels). Since 2003 Jukka is a regular delegate to the Midwest Clinic in Chicago.

A word from his mentor, associate professor (ret.) of music **Paul Niemisto**, St. Olaf College, MN, USA: "Jukka Viitasaari is an unique voice in Finnish band music in that he strives to incorporate old traditional folk music idioms, rock and jazz into modern formats."

Français: **Jukka Viitasaari** (né en 1961 / alias "Viitasaurus") a connu plusieurs décennies de succès en tant que compositeur pour orchestres d'harmonie. À ce jour, il a reçu sept prix finlandais et seize prix internationaux de composition pour orchestre. Il s'est produit avec des fanfares, des orchestres d'harmonie et, fidèle à sa génération, avec des big bands et des groupes de rock.

Depuis 2008, il est membre de la Société des compositeurs finlandais et membre du conseil d'administration de la WASBE pour 2019-2026. Il siège également au conseil d'administration de l'Association finlandaise des orchestres d'harmonie SPOL et de Finn-Band, l'association des éditeurs finlandais d'orchestres.

Viitasaari a publié plus de soixante œuvres en Finlande et plus de vingt autres aux États-Unis par TRN Music Publisher, BRS-Music, Potenza Music, Leading Tones Music, Grand Mesa Music et Alfred Music, et en Europe par Carpe Diem Musikverlag.

Il a présenté des stages à la Penfield High School en 2013 et à l'Arizona State University en 2018 sur l'écriture de musique pour les groupes. En 2019, il a coprésenté avec le compositeur Jukka-Pekka Lehto une conférence intitulée "A Shape of Finns to come" lors de la conférence mondiale de la WASBE à Buñol, en Espagne, en juillet 2019. En 2022, il a présenté des stages à Riga, en Lettonie (la scène finlandaise des orchestres d'harmonie) et à Linköping, en Suède (Nordic Composers Seminarium sur l'écriture pour différents niveaux d'orchestres). Depuis 2003, Jukka est régulièrement délégué à la Midwest Clinic de Chicago.

Un mot de son mentor, le professeur associé (retraité) de musique **Paul Niemisto**, St. Olaf College, MN, USA : "Jukka Viitasaari est une voix unique dans la musique d'orchestre finlandaise en ce sens qu'il s'efforce d'incorporer d'anciens idiomes de musique folklorique traditionnelle, du rock et du jazz dans des formats modernes."

Deutsch: **Jukka Viitasaari** (geb. 1961/aka "Viitasaurus") ist seit vielen Jahrzehnten erfolgreich als Komponist für Blasorchester tätig. Bis heute wurde er mit sieben finnischen und 16 internationalen Preisen für Blasorchesterkompositionen ausgezeichnet. Er hat mit Brass Bands, Blaskapellen und, ganz im Sinne seiner Generation, mit Big Bands und Rockbands gespielt.

Seit 2008 ist er Mitglied der Finnish Composers Society und Vorstandsmitglied der WASBE für 2019-2026. Außerdem ist er Mitglied des Vorstands des finnischen Blasmusikverbands SPOL und von FinnBand, Finnish Band Publishers United.

Viitasaari hat mehr als sechzig Werke in Finnland und über zwanzig weitere in den USA bei TRN Music Publisher, BRS-Music, Potenza Music, Leading Tones Music, Grand Mesa Music und Alfred Music und in Europa beim Carpe Diem Musikverlag veröffentlicht.

Er hat 2013 an der Penfield High School und 2018 an der Arizona State University Seminare über das Schreiben von Musik für Bands gehalten. Im Jahr 2019 hielt er zusammen mit dem Komponisten Jukka-Pekka Lehto den Vortrag "A Shape of Finns to come" auf der WASBE-Weltkonferenz in Buñol, Spanien im Juli 2019. Im Jahr 2022 gab er Seminare in Riga, Lettland (die finnische Blasmusikszene) und Linköping, Schweden (Nordic Composers Seminarium über das Schreiben für verschiedene Bandstufen). Seit 2003 nimmt Jukka regelmäßig an der Midwest Clinic in Chicago teil.

Ein Wort seines Mentors, des emeritierten Musikprofessors **Paul Niemisto** vom St. Olaf College, MN, USA: "Jukka Viitasaari ist eine einzigartige Stimme in der finnischen Blasmusik, da er danach strebt, alte traditionelle Volksmusikidiome, Rock und Jazz in moderne Formate zu integrieren."
