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# Valentin Duc



**Français:** Né le 2 mars 1995 à Sierre, Valentin Duc est un musicien et soliste suisse, passionné par la musique et doté d'une riche expérience musicale et académique.

Il a suivi une formation en solfège au Conservatoire de Sion, où il a acquis de solides bases théoriques. En tant qu'euphonium solo, il a évolué au sein de prestigieux ensembles tels que le Valaisia Brass Band, la Fanfare Ancienne Cécilia de Chermignon, le Brass Band National des Jeunes, le Brass Band Européen des Jeunes, le Swiss Army Brass Band et le Tredegar Town Band (Pays de Galles). Il est également membre du quatuor Shake Brass, avec lequel il explore un répertoire varié et dynamique.

Parallèlement à sa carrière musicale, Valentin a obtenu un Bachelor en Management à l'École des Hautes Études Commerciales de Lausanne et un Master en Droit, Criminalité et Sécurité des Technologies de l'Information à l'Université de Lausanne, témoignant de sa polyvalence et de son engagement académique.

Fort de ses compétences musicales, académiques et professionnelles, Valentin Duc incarne une personnalité talentueuse et engagée dans plusieurs domaines.

*Composée à l'occasion des 60 ans de la société de musique Enzian D'Erschmatt, la marche "Roggenmarsch" est un hommage vibrant à l'histoire de cet ensemble. **English:** Born on March 2nd, 1995, in Sierre, Valentin Duc is a Swiss musician and soloist with a deep passion for music and extensive experience in both musical and academic fields.

He trained in music theory at the Conservatory of Sion, building a strong theoretical foundation. As a euphonium soloist, he has performed with prestigious ensembles such as the Valaisia Brass Band, the Fanfare Ancienne Cécilia of Chermignon, the National Youth Brass Band, the European Youth Brass Band, the Swiss Army Brass Band and the Tredegar Town Band (Wales). He is also a member of the Shake Brass quartet, exploring a diverse and dynamic repertoire.

In addition to his musical career, Valentin received a Bachelor's degree in Management from the School of Business and Economics in Lausanne (HEC) and a Master's degree in Law, Crime, and Information Technology Security from the University of Lausanne, showcasing his versatility and academic dedication.

With his musical, academic, and professional expertise, Valentin Duc is a talented and multi-faceted personality.

*Composed for the 60th anniversary of the Enzian D'Erschmatt music ensemble, the 'Roggenmarsch' march is a vibrant tribute to the ensemble's history. Inspired by the Alpine landscape and the character of the local music, it combines tradition and dynamism in a lively, festive melody. The name 'Roggenmarsch' evokes both robustness and vitality, symbolising the strength and passion of the musicians who continue this heritage. With its strong melodic motifs and driving rhythm, this work reflects the enthusiasm and conviviality that have animated the ensemble for six decades.*

**Deutsch:** Valentin Duc, geboren am 2. März 1995 in Siders, ist ein Schweizer Musiker und Solist mit einer großen Leidenschaft für Musik und einer umfassenden Erfahrung in musikalischen und akademischen Bereichen.

Er erhielt eine Ausbildung in Musiktheorie am Konservatorium von Sitten und baute dort eine solide theoretische Grundlage auf. Als Euphonium-Solist spielte er in renommierten Ensembles wie der Valaisia Brass Band, der Fanfare Ancienne Cécilia von Chermignon, der Nationalen Jugend-Brass-Band, der Europäischen Jugend-Brass-Band, der Swiss Army Brass Band und der Tredegar Town Band (Wales). Er ist auch Mitglied des Quartetts Shake Brass, mit dem er ein abwechslungsreiches und dynamisches Repertoire erkundet.

Neben seiner musikalischen Karriere erwarb Valentin einen Bachelor in Management an der Hochschule für Wirtschaft Lausanne (HEC) und einen Master in Recht, Kriminalität und Sicherheit von Informationstechnologien an der Universität Lausanne, was seine Vielseitigkeit und sein akademisches Engagement unterstreicht.

Mit seinen musikalischen, akademischen und beruflichen Fähigkeiten ist Valentin Duc eine vielseitig talentierte Persönlichkeit.
